Liberty to Minister More Initiative

The Liberty to Minister More Initiative was set up in 2017. The purpose of this initiative was to provide an opportunity for giving directly related to debt reduction. Currently, Liberty Baptist Church has \$1,088,292 in debt. Through this initiative, the debt has been reduced by \$443,198, saving approximately \$148,000 in interest payments. When this initiative was implemented, those who participated made a 3-year commitment. While many continue to give even though their 3-year commitment has expired, this fresh initiative gives an opportunity for others to join and those who are currently giving to restate their commitment. At the current rate of giving \$72,000 per year, we would be debt free by 2029, seven years from now. If the current rate of giving could be increased to \$140,000 per year, then we would be able to be debt free in five years. We are in a good financial situation and are managing our debt well. However, ideally it is best to be debt-free as soon as possible. We are merely asking for the congregation to state your level of commitment to debt reduction for planning purposes. These formal pledges are not binding; however, they will enable the church to financially plan and will hopefully hasten to the church being debt-free.
