The Present Need For Persistent Humble Prayer in God's Kingdom

Luke 18:1-14; 11:5-8

The Parable & The Interpretation (The Unjust Judge)

- There was a judge who was unconcerned with justice
- There was a widow who persistently asked for justice
- The judge granted her justice because of her persistent asking

Christians remain persistent in prayer believing in God for future vindication.

The Parable & The Interpretation (The Pharisee & The Tax Collector)

- A Pharisee prayed in a self-righteous manner
- A tax collector prayed in a self-abasing manner

"I tell you, this one went down to his house justified rather than the other; because everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

The Parable & The Interpretation (The Friend at Midnight)

- A person goes to his friend at midnight to get bread to feed a guest
- The friend initially refuses to get him bread due to the late hour
- Because of the persistence of the person bread is given
