Matthew 21:28-46, 22:1-14; Mark 12:1-12; Luke 13:6-9; 14:15-24

## The Parable \& The Interpretation (The Two Sons)

- One son said he would not work but did work
- The other son said he would work but did not work

Lived obedience is a good indicator of actual belief.

## The Parable \& The Interpretation (The Barren Fig Tree)

- A fig tree produced no fruit
- The lack of fruitfulness made its removal imminent without change

The call for fruitfulness considering God's ultimate judgment should be heard with urgency.

## The Parable \& The Interpretation (The Wicked Tenants)

- A landowner planted a vineyard and leased it to tenant farmers
- A landowner sent his slaves to collect fruit, but the farmers harmed or killed the slaves
- A landowner sent his son, and the tenant farmers killed the son

Those who should have received the prophets and Jesus, killed them.

## The Parable \& The Interpretation (The Wedding Banquet And The Feast)

- A king gave a wedding banquet for his son
- A king sent out slaves to summon those invited
- The invited either refused to come or were hostile to the slaves
- A king widened his invitation to the banquet

Only those who give a proper response to God are part of the people of God.
