### Harvest Day Offering Goal (\$50,000)

Every year we designate a special offering for a special project during Harvest Day (our 188<sup>th</sup> anniversary). The goal is to raise \$50,000 for our greenspace/park. Liberty Baptist Church owns 12 acres of land across the street that is utilized for recreation and community events. The following upgrades are being recommended:

- install a 1-mile gravel (crush-and-run) track and install two bridges over the creek for the track to utilize the entire property
- extend the intramural field by piping the creek 290 ft to not interrupt the play area
- lay back creek banks to make them easier to maintain
- reseed all affected areas with grass
