Revelation 8:2-10:11

1. To have future hope, we must know God will judge human sinfulness and humanity is resistant to repent even after experiencing the consequences of their sin (Revelation 8:2-9:21)
 - a. first trumpet (8:6-7) – 1/3 of the land and trees burned
 - b. second trumpet (8:8-9) – 1/3 of the sea and its creatures killed
 - c. third trumpet (8:10-11) – 1/3 of the river and springs poisoned
 - d. fourth trumpet (8:12) – partial darkening of the sun, moon, and stars
 - f. fifth trumpet/first woe (9:1-12) – unleashing of demonic activity
 - g. sixth trumpet/second woe (9:13-21) – demonic activity killing 1/3 of humanity
 - *no desire for repentance of survivors (9:20-21)
 - h. seventh trumpet/third woe (11:15-19) – heavenly praise of God's enacted justice with lightning, thunder, and hail
2. To have future hope, we must embrace the bittersweet responsibility of sharing God's truth with the world (Revelation 10:1-11; see Ezekiel 3:1-11)
