Romans 9-1-29

1. Israel as a people/nation has been given special privileges by God (Romans 9:1-5)

- a. The privileges (the adoption, the glory, the covenant, the law, the temple service, the promises, the forefather (patriarchs), and the genealogical line of the Messiah (Romans 9:3-5)

- a. All who are ethnic Jews and *not* part of God's redemptive-historical plan (Romans 9:6-13)
