Our Stinking Thinking

Romans 1:18-23; 7:14-25

1. To change our thinking, we must realize that we resist rational evidence about God from creation (Rom 1:18-21)
2. To change our thinking, we must realize that a failure to worship God with our minds leads toward self-worship and greater confusion (Rom 1:22-25)
3. To change our thinking, we must realize that mere knowledge of God and His ways will not change our mind (Rom 7:14-23)
4. To change our thinking, we must realize our deep need for a mind/heart transformation to be rescued from our futile thinking (Rom 7:24-25)

Thought Exercise: Identify ways that self-centeredness is evident in your thinking. Analyze how self-centered thinking can cloud your mind of God's goodness and the needs of others. Assess how merely knowing what to do does not often accomplish doing it. Why is this the case?

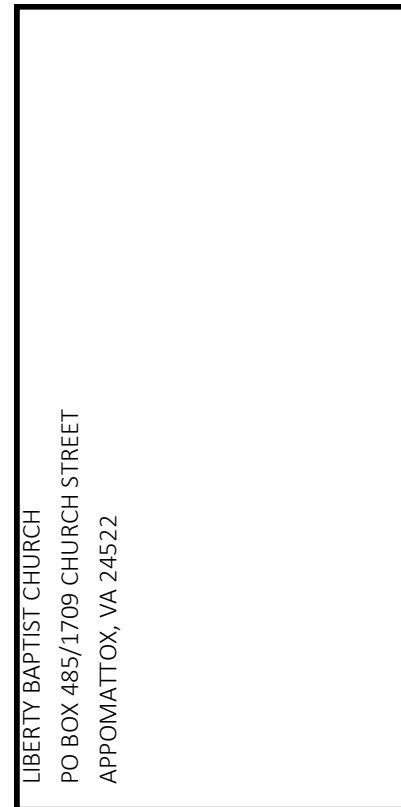
