**Church On The Move Through
 New Conversions and Rich Community**
Acts 2:41-47

The early church had an attractive quality to it. The early Christians engaged in a manner of life that was spiritually nourishing and attractive to outsiders. The major aspects of the early church's manner of life were as follows: First, they were students of the Scriptures. They learned the Scriptures in both formal and informal settings. Second, they lived life together. They had deep fellowship with one another. They would share meals and spend time in the homes with one another. Third, they gave sacrificially to one another. They took particular care in aiding one another in meeting needs. Fourth, they were people of prayer and had an awareness of the Holy Spirit's work in their midst. Fifth, they were people of worship being faithful to observe the Lord's Supper and celebrate new converts through baptism. Sixth, the uniqueness of their community established a positive rapport with outsiders. Seventh, they engaged in Spirit-filled Gospel proclamation and God blessed this through the steady addition of new Christians.
