**On The Move Through Fresh Organization**

*Acts 6:1-7*

As the early church grows, it experiences growing pains. One of the earliest growing pains is the abundance of need and the shortage of help (Acts 6:1). The apostles were already at capacity thus a new church office was developed. This was the office of a deacon. Seven men were chosen to give special care for the widows (Acts 6:2-6). This selection process took place under the leadership of the apostles and the approval of the congregation. This enabled the ministry of the early church to expand and flourish (Acts 6:7). There is a more profound truth in this text than merely the establishment of the office of the deacon. The church would face several crisis points that would call for fresh organization. God would call his church to greater outreach to gentiles which would cause reorganization and a change of mind (Acts 10:34-48). God would call his church to reorganize for the purpose of sending missionaries (Acts 13:1-3). God would call his church to reorganize for the purpose of accommodating new gentile converts (Acts 15). This would ultimately achieve the Gospel reaching Rome (Acts 28).

**Reflection Point** – How is God calling us to reorganize to face the need of the moment? How can our reorganization expand the reach of the ministry of Liberty Baptist Church?
