Jesus reveals the true intentions behind God's commands. True righteousness proceeds from the heart into one's lifestyle. The prohibition to not murder attempts to stop one of the most harmful human activities. Jesus probes how a murderous heart develops. A person cultivates a murderous heart through unresolved anger and a need to overpower others (Matt 5:21-22). Jesus gives two examples concerning the need to resolve anger and pursue peace. The first example is a call to radical reconciliation in the life of the church. Jesus states that acts of reconciliation with other Christians are more important than individual worship. What makes this radical reconciliation is that the offended person is not the worshipper, but the worshipper realizes that someone else is offended by him. The worshipper attempts reconciliation with one who has something against him (Matt 5:23-24). The second example of a radical act of reconciliation is with those outside the church. The Christian must attempt to bring peace to a situation and settle a matter in the least disruptive way possible. The failure of the Christian to attempt peace will cause them to stand under divine disapproval (Matt 5:25-26).

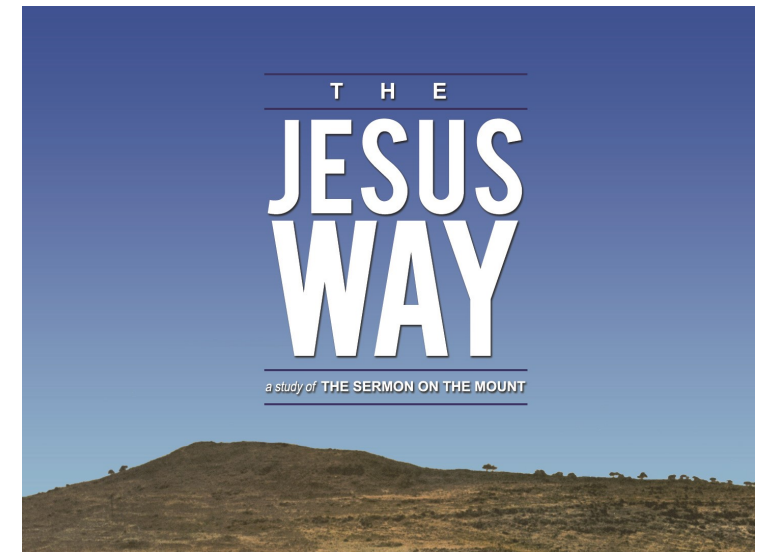
