**On Prayer**

*Matthew 6:1-18; 7:7-11*

Jesus is describing for his disciples the nature of heart-religion. Jesus wants our change to be external only when it genuinely follows from our internal heart change. Religious practices are good if they enable internal change. Jesus calls his disciples to avoid the missteps of false religious piety. Jesus wants his disciples to be generous, but not for the praise of others (Matt 6:1-4). Jesus wants his disciples to fast, but not to be seen by others. These spiritual disciplines should encourage heart-change which will lead to right behavior if done correctly. One area where the disciple should not misstep is in prayer. Proper praying must be learned and cultivated; it is not naturally accomplished. Praying can be and often is done incorrectly. Jesus corrects praying that misunderstands the nature of prayer and the nature of God (Matt 6:5-8). The Lord's Prayer provides the kind of praying appropriate for a Christian. The Lord's Prayer reveals the nature of our communion as Christians. Notice the use of "our," not "my" through the prayer. Further, a Christian understand God as Father, and yet as holy (Matt 6:9). A Christian is looking for God's work to be done both now and in the future, "on the earth" (Matt 6:10-11). The Christian is to realize God knows their needs, but through prayer can ask and receive the full provision of God for both himself and others (Matt 6:11). The Christian is to be aware of their sins and is willing to express forgiveness to others (Mat 6:12, 14). In prayer, the disciple is aware of the reality of testing and the need to be spiritually prepared for an attack by the evil one (Matt 6:13). The Christian boldly asks knowing God, the loving heavenly Father, desires to give good things to his children (Matt 7:7-11).

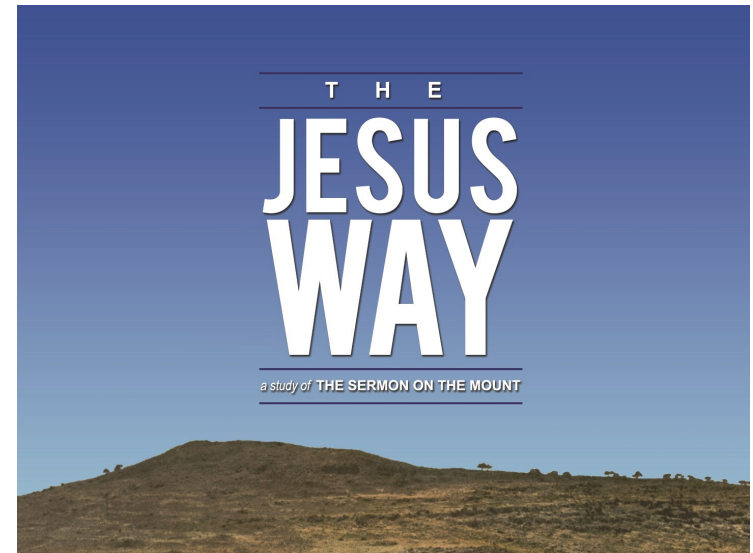
